1 - The Planets, Their Symbolism and Meaning



The Moon

The **MOON** is the swiftest moving of the ten bodies we study. She moves through all twelve signs about every twenty-eight days. She is perpetually in motion.

Our everyday routines reflect her waxing and waning. The moon represents the common, the ordinary, the everyday and its people.

Imagine the MOON cooking a big family dinner.

First, she investigates the cupboards and freezer looking for the needed provisions. She will be selecting from meat, poultry, fish or vegetarian choices. Then she decides if she will bake, boil, grill or sauté the main course. It might even be a cold dish that she dreams up. Her **New Moon** phase is much like the starting point of the meal.

At the **First Quarter** of the Moon, she will be busily putting together the right side dishes and starting to think about a tasty dessert.

This is where she may encounter her first issues; the rice must be pulled off quickly or it will overcook, or the potatoes need to be mashed just when the gravy is starting to thicken.

If she resolves the problems that arise now, she can set the table and call everyone in to eat.

As she lays out all the delicious fixings, we see how this resembles the **Full Moon** phase.

This is where the efforts made from the start of the New Moon show their greatest accomplishment. Just like the big ol' Full Moon shining up in the sky, the completed meal is ready to be consumed.

She can take in the compliments or let out some steam, depending on the finished product.

As the moon starts to decrease in size, so does the amount of food left on the table. If she forgot to take the strawberries out and cut them up for the dessert, she will be in a hurry to finish them, whip the heavy cream and get the shortcakes out of the oven. Here, at the **Last Quarter** phase, she meets these challenges by serving up a mouthwatering dessert, just as everyone is groaning that they cannot possibly eat another morsel!

Just as soon as everyone pushes back from the table thoroughly satisfied, the moon goes into her **Final Phase** of clearing the table, putting away leftovers and tidying up the dishes. This closely resembles the **Waning Moon**, finishing any loose ends.

Every 28 days of the Moon's cyclic activity mirrors this type of domestic event.

What we have just observed is the moon in action. Since the moon symbolizes the home and women, the analogy to the family dinner can keep in your mind the mission the moon has every month.

The moon has a close relationship to the Fourth House.



The Sun

When we even dare to peek at the SUN, his brilliance can be enough to temporarily blind us. This is akin to judging people by their sun signs. Temporarily, we are blinded by the high energy this vital body emits so we may overlook other worthwhile traits someone possesses.

The SUN is number one on the music charts, the most often played tune, the song with the most memorable words. They roll off our lips without giving it much thought. The SUN is how we most often project our ego.

We are most comfortable when we can easily project the qualities of our SUN sign.

You can judge how consistent the SUN is by its predictable path.

In the spring at the vernal equinox, it marches into motion.

It will take roughly a month to pass through each sign of the zodiac. This never changes from year to year.

Our calendar corresponds to the movement of the SUN through the signs.

The heat from SUN warms any other planet it contacts. But, it tends to outshine any planets that are very close. This characteristic of the SUN plays an important role when you begin to interpret the Horoscope.

Since most people know their SUN sign, it is easier to interpret the meaning given to the SUN through each sign. People can readily identify with the traits of their SUN sign.

The Sun has a close relationship with the Fifth House of the Horoscope.



Mercury

When we think of MERCURY, it reminds us of quicksilver, the substance that used to be in thermometers. MERCURY adjusts its size according to the temperature. It expands in the heat and retracts in the cold.

In early myths, MERCURY was the Messenger of the Gods. MERCURY personifies Communication.

MERCURY stays pretty close to the Sun all year long, maybe lagging behind or forging in front of the Sun a bit.

If MERCURY is in the same sign as the Sun, we sometimes see a little less objectivity, a little more embracing of one's own words and thoughts.

This tendency is most pronounced when the Sun and MERCURY are in Leo.

This is less discernable, but still present, when the Sun and MERCURY are in the opposite sign of Aquarius.

More than other planets, MERCURY takes on the flavor of any planets close to it. When we hop in the car to go on errands, MERCURY is on display as it is when we write short notes or articles.

MERCURY in the Horoscope shows how our communications work for us.

Since MERCURY is sexless, it represents brothers and sisters of ours with whom we have a sexless relationship. Since MERCURY is sexless, it can take masculine or feminine roles with equal balance. Learning - as separate from education – is a task performed equally well by either sex.

This is why we look to MERCURY to see a person's ability to learn. MERCURY holds sway over the Third and Sixth houses of the horoscope.



Venus

VENUS reminds me of beauty. She is the Love Goddess, surrounding herself with ardent admirers. She is all things feminine.

Ponder the Orchid corsage; beautiful, delicate, in good taste and expensive.

Let us go shopping for an outfit with VENUS. It has to be color-coordinated, flattering and tasteful, within her budget and it has to appeal to her significant other.

The black and checked dress is made for her! The square cut neckline emphasizes her graceful shoulders and comely neck.


She can wear her matching diamond pendant and earrings.


I will leave it to your imagination to visualize the havoc carried into the lives of all the present residents and shopkeepers.

Pluto

I was secretly elated when the big shots decided to demote **PLUTO**.

He had been hanging out with the seediest gangsters and wise guys and forcing his way into all kinds of businesses.

The trouble is that, since his demotion, I've noticed he's more like the guy next door. Mr. Next-door doesn't hold down a job and there have been a steady stream of waif-like females in and out of his house. Then, the story broke in the papers that he was running call girls from his home computer. Yes, a snake can change its skin, but it's still a snake!

He has also been having a cozy, decade's long relationship with Uranus. Uranus will settle in a community and announce a series of civic improvement projects. Of course, relocation for any of the affected residents was carefully specified in the contracts.

Nevertheless, PLUTO demanded a cut of the action and, because of their long-standing relationship, Uranus awarded him the contracts for relocating all the displaced citizens.

These people, for the most part, ended up without their money or their business.

But, there were a few who were willing to play PLUTO'S dark secret games and who actually came out of the shake-up wealthy business and property owners.

The sheer force of PLUTO'S violent eruptions drowned out whispers of shady deals.

I know PLUTO is not the threat it once was, because Uranus has figured out how to do pretty much do all the same destructive things as PLUTO.

In addition, I hear this fact altered their relationship considerably. They barely meet these days. Moreover, when they do, it is usually an awkward mis-step and they pivot and spin in opposite directions.

Chapter Two: The Signs The Road the Planets Choose



Aries

First, we encounter **ARIES**. A planet choosing the ARIES road, will find itself on a Drag Raceway:

They have to be first. Winning is paramount - move quickly to the head of the line.

Let us try out our friend, the Moon, on the drag raceway that is ARIES.

We know the Moon has its phases. If we are looking at the first quarter Moon in high-spirited Aries, this, most likely, places the Sun in Capricorn.

Glancing back at the Moon fixing dinner, the First Quarter was when the Moon ran into some obstacles.

We might infer from the previous chapter that, if the Moon were in a big hurry because of her placement in ARIES, the whole meal would turn into a burned, sticky mess!

Compounding the problem would be the Capricorn Sun requiring her to pay dearly for this disaster.

We see the Moon getting on the phone and ordering from a nearby restaurant. The added expense for the wasted food and costly take-out order causes the Moon to go over her budget and experience a financial crisis later in the month.

This creates tension for the Moon, as she always likes to stay within her budget.

When the Sun picks ARIES every spring, we see the speeded-up growth and continuous blossoming of the early season flowers. The ARIES sun can be viewed as somewhat precocious; always dipping into new sources of energy to spur itself on to greater accomplishments.

As the sun enters ARIES in March, people usually re-evaluate their cars or trucks. Maybe they need new tires for higher performance or their battery just barely made it through the winter and demands replacement.

There is a surge in purchases seen at the car dealerships and parts stores. Mechanics are booking more routine tune-ups, all because the consumer is intent on improving the feats their cars can accomplish.

The Sun in ARIES is all about peak output. ARIES sun people are always pushing themselves to achieve, to be first and to be best.

Mercury in ARIES answers your questions before you ask. They are eager to read the last chapter in that steamy romance; a genre that appeals to their highly-sexualized imagination. Mercury in ARIES likes Post-it[®] notes because they can quickly jot down the thoughts that speed through their minds before another idea takes shape.

When a woman with Venus in ARIES enters a nightclub, she acts and dresses as though she's the main act on stage. Here, Venus gives into the glitzy, sexy ARIES.

If she is wearing fishnet hose, a rhinestone on red halter and shiny black mini skirt, you don't even have to go online and check out her birth chart. She has Venus in ARIES. Similarly, men with Venus placed in ARIES find that "in your face" style quite a turn-on.

Man your positions! Full speed ahead! This is Mars in ARIES. There are new battles to be fought daily. Mars in ARIES is in its own element. The high energy accompanying this placement can accomplish tremendous amounts of work. The Mars in ARIES individual works extremely hard all day and slips into bed at night eager to play.

If Jupiter is located on the ARIES speedway, the individual finds an eagerness for life's experience that sometimes foregoes higher education. Their motto should be Live and Learn. They make some of the finest mechanics, technicians and surgical aides. They keep expanding their knowledge of the job years after they have mastered the skill.

Saturn in ARIES tends to demand perfection. Being first becomes being first with the best laid-out plan. Strangely, inertia can strike these individuals. They find the slightest bit of oil on their car engine and refuse to enter the race. They never trust their exactingly thought-through plan for action.

In this sense, they probably make great planners, but the fear of a slight mistake prevents them from taking the action necessary once the plan is completed. A "back to the drawing board" mentality, constantly nags at them.

It takes about eighty-four years for Uranus to move through all twelve signs. So, this is very much a generation placement (all people born during each seven year span will have Uranus in the same sign).

During the seven years Uranus spends in Aries, some of the most advanced and surprising innovations happen in the area of automobiles. Inventors of breathtaking concepts in automotive engineering can be found with this placement.

It also serves well for the Generals planning military battles. Their brilliant strategies to conquer the enemy sometimes find their way into military history annals.

Being a slow mover, Neptune is a bit out of its element in the fast-moving lane ARIES presents. Neptune's navigation usually involves large bodies of water or fog-laden countryside.

The question is how quickly can they really be traversed?

Or, is it even wise to attempt a speedy crossing?

Since Neptune hasn't been in ARIES for over one hundred years, our firsthand knowledge is absent about this placement.

As with Neptune, Pluto takes its own good time moving through the signs. We wouldn't be badly served if we glanced back into history for salient examples of both Neptune and Pluto in ARIES as these placements will be coming up again in the next fifty or sixty years.

My musings on Pluto in ARIES, conjure up visions of nations burning through mountains of the public's money.

I see armies using devious, underhanded tactics to win wars.

Cars? Maybe they truly will run on water! But, what's in the water? And will it be rationed? Hum.........

Here we are back observing the Moon who has embarked on the TAURUS thoroughfare. She has her prettiest apron on while she carefully washes her hand-painted bone china (dinner service for twelve). She smiles, remembering the compliments that she received when she used it for the highly successful family gathering yesterday.

She wanted to spend the last bit of time with the relatives, so she only rinsed and stacked the dinnerware last night.

As comfortable as the Moon is when she's in TAURUS, she's expected to have a big bank account.

She acknowledges that she must have the top-of-the-line provisions and you can't always find them on the close-out counter!



Taurus

Flowers, flowers everywhere! It must be May! When the Sun ambles down the road much is in bloom. The sun is displaying its most fertile, attractive side.

Talk about dimpled darlings! When Venus in TAURUS is presented for her coming out party, we see all the charm and beauty that personifies the sign TAURUS. All the foregoing comes with a price! Expect weekly facials and manicures. A beauty mask will be found in the Venus-in-TAURUS Chippendale table, next to the King-sized bed.

The costly designer clothes hanging in all three of their closets may be a few years old, but they wreak of timeless elegance and fine taste.

Venus in TAURUS is also not fond of one-night stands. They attract the wealthiest, best educated prospects and proceed on to marrying upwards.

Mars struggles to get let on to the TAURUS thoroughfare. Mars is used to speeding up and passing around anyone not moving up to speed. Mars questions; "What's all this letting the person on the left go first?" TAURUS, if anything, is an agreeable sign. Mars wants to win, period. TAURUS asks "win what - first place in the graveyard? No, thank you, I'll move at my pace."

Mars is slowed down by the style and elegance TAURUS infuses. TAURUS asks why buy a racy sports car? Don't you want to be comfortable? Mars in TAURUS may also have large sensual appetites, but the courses are taken slowly.

As Jupiter ambles into TAURUS, with preconceived notions firmly in place, we see them choosing a transcontinental flight for this trip. That will give them plenty of time to go over the lecture they will be giving in the upcoming semester. These aren't new ideas Jupiter will be presenting, but the audience will be fresh.

For the past twenty-five years Jupiter has been lecturing on the botanical significances in contrasting philosophies. Each semester, new faces find fascination with the same well-worn ideas. Jupiter in TAURUS won't break new ground in their field. But, they will provide a pleasant diversion for hungry minds.

If you've ever had a banker turn you down for a loan, you are already acquainted with Saturn in TAURUS. As TAURUS confides to his friends and family that he has made these plans, some of the history of the Tunnel comes out through these conversations.

Does TAURUS want to be knee-deep in stagnant water?

How about the giant species of rodents that populate the place? Will those be to his liking?

It is no use!

Every time TAURUS attempts to have a friendly relationship with Pluto, it turns in to a fight for survival. Nevertheless, Pluto has always returned to TAURUS each time with new schemes. Actually, the rumor is that TAURUS, through his influential position on several boards, started the movement to demote Pluto years before their planned, upcoming meeting.

We can reflect backward to the latter part of the nineteenth century when Pluto last hooked up with TAURUS. Check it out to familiarize yourself with famous people born during that time and the events that shaped the period.

I am pretty well versed on Saturn in GEMINI. My father had it, my
grandfather had it and I too have Saturn in GEMINI.

Since it takes twenty-eight to thirty years for Saturn to cover all twelve signs, most people reach mental maturity when Saturn returns for the first time to the position it was in at your birth.



College Deans and Chairmen of the Alumnae are often found to have Jupiter placed in LEO in the horoscope. It might be their gregarious manner that

All that glitters is not gold when Neptune takes up residence in Leo. Much of this will apply to persons with their Sun aligned with Neptune. Heads of government and businesses aren't very different from crooks and gangsters. At least, that is how it is perceived by Pluto in LEO. They both forcibly take your money and give nothing but misery and domination in return.

Pluto was residing in Leo during much of the 1940's and 1950's. This is by no means when all the criminals took over big business and government, but this era paved the road for legitimization of racketeers.

Jupiter is somewhat stifled and cramped in VIRGO. Jupiter has very big ideas, VIRGO analysis finds fault with most of them. Grand sweeping plans can be whittled away into small utilitarian projects.

These folks can be found in travel agencies, planning every excruciating detail for you. If you want a vacation without ANY surprises, these are the ones to plan your trip.

The Commissioner of Civil Service for a nearby city has this placement. She is patient and thorough, examining the educational credentials and prior work references for prospective city employees. She has never been late for work

or missed a day. And, she is suspicious of those applying for work if they have any prior history of tardiness or absenteeism. There is no such thing as purposefully planned, well thought out sheer luck; this is the dichotomy for the Jupiter in VIRGO individual.

Watching Saturn in VIRGO is much like watching paint dry. And, those bestowed with this placement are every bit as exciting. They are punctual, abstemious, quite thrifty and not above foregoing lunch to finish up a project at work.

They take their occupation very seriously, and their impeccable habits usually favor them for the climb to leadership in their profession. They are no strangers to long hours and low wages. They have usually started near the bottom of the business ladder and, through their hard work and ceaseless attention to minor details, they obtain small but significant promotions until they reach the executive level.

The top position usually eludes them, since it would be bestowed on a more congenial, more popular peer.

Nothing can personify Uranus in VIRGO for me like the freeing of slaves. Although Uranus was not in VIRGO when the African slaves were freed in the United States, there is the symbolism of this placement throughout the history of serfdom.

There is a tendency with Uranus in VIRGO to do whatever is expedient. During this last go-round with Uranus in VIRGO, roughly the years 1962 to 1970, moral equivalency reared its head big-time.

Many of the social injustices that had been culturally ingrained in the USA were overthrown or challenged to their core. Mostly, this affected African Americans and women; both had been treated by the law as second-class citizens.

Presently, Uranus is visiting VIRGO'S opposite; Pisces, but more on that later.

While Neptune was courteously visiting VIRGO, healthcare professionals were seen as Florence Nightingale and Dr. Kildare; sacrificing themselves trying to care for ill people and divining the course of treatment.

Florence Nightingale is now believed to have suffered from Chronic Fatigue Syndrome. This disease had been thought of for years as nothing more than "goldbricking".

This is typical of the dichotomous hazy link between Neptune's imaginary ailments and VIRGO'S obsession with the work ethic.

Pluto's transit of VIRGO makes me think of the organization of Civil Servants and restaurant employees; labor unions (Pluto) organizing masses of workers (VIRGO).

The forty-something's today were born when Pluto was occupying VIRGO. As they entered the work force, the saying "Work is a four-letter word" was validated. This group, more than any other before it, was poorly equipped to put forth the sustained effort to succeed purely on their own merits.

They prefer to get pay raises automatically tied to the standard of living. If a larger increase is needed, they will move on to another employer who is willing to lure them away with the promise of a higher salary and better benefits.

Those with Pluto in VIRGO will rarely be found working for the same company their entire career.

Job hopping is the name of the game.



Libra

She has one of her frilly aprons on as she whips up the Quiche Lorraine.

She's already arranged the shrimp in lovely rows on the hors-d'œuvre table next to the fruit and cheese sampler.

Her older sister will be bringing her new husband and LIBRA moon is so glad she's finally gotten married! It's a must, she thinks, if you want true happiness. She would be lost without her own hubby.

The seating was an important consideration when LIBRA moon started planning this event. She harmoniously chose male, female rotation around the table. She had to do some juggling to make it come out right, what with her younger brother just going through a divorce, and baby sister's latest significant other not really hitting it off with too many in the family.

This is going to be a congenial gathering, no matter what. LIBRA moon doesn't like any friction.

After the bountiful harvest that was the Sun in Virgo, we witness the lessenergized Sun in LIBRA. Plants aren't bursting into bloom anymore. The leaves are losing their dark green hue. She truly appreciates all the finer things life has to offer. And they come to her with ease.

She never brags or boasts about how well she's doing.

She doesn't have to....it's obvious!

In LIBRA, Mars breezes in with his convertible top down letting the sun warm his golden tanned skin. He knows the speed limit and keeps just a few miles above it, raising no radar attention. He was stopped once, but his agreeable manner soon charmed the female patrol officer out of a ticket and into a date. He was single at the time.

His second wife wanted her space and he graciously didn't battle her in the courts. He obtained an equitable settlement due to the fact that she was heiress to a fortune, and he had been a patient and accommodating lover all during their seven-year marriage.

Mars in LIBRA always gives as good as they get. He has found this trait particularly useful in his antique business. He does not mind paying well for the estate items he purchases.

He has a talent for spiffing them up and turning an enormous profit.

The placement of Mars in LIBRA endows one with a skilled eye for the Antique Market. These natives have been known to uncover priceless collector pieces, making their previous owners a handsome offer and tripling their own investment through an advantageous sale.

Jupiter in LIBRA does quite well in marriage also. They only get tripped up when they fall for their attorney after the third divorce. Until then, they had always used the marriage laws very much to their own advantage.

Jupiter in LIBRA also endows it's natives with an appreciation for all facets of the Judicial System. They can be found in the Domestic Relations Court, but also make excellent Divorce Attorneys. As Police Officers, they are usually sent to "family trouble" calls. The outcome can be more peaceful by their presence.

The law is the law! This statement reflects the sentiment of Saturn in LIBRA.

They rarely take their marriage vows lightly. They aren't found so much as spitting on the sidewalk. Saturn in LIBRA follows the letter of the law.

When they are on the bench, the offenders get stern, but always fair treatment.

They can recall obscure Judicial decisions that they studied twenty years ago, if the decision applies in a current case.

As we reach the closing days of October, the Sun shifts into SCORPIO. The nights are much longer now. So much more time to spend in bed, if that's what you like, and Sun in SCORPIO likes it very much.

They can trace the motives for most of the decisions they've made throughout their life. Or maybe we should say, "motive".

Start with going to a known party college; why? Sex will be easier to obtain.

Next, major in medicine; why? Medical professionals are more of a turn on to others.

Upon graduation, open a private practice; why? It's easier to fit an afternoon dalliance into the schedule when you book your own appointments.

Rock on, SCORPIO.

Okay, maybe that's a bit extreme.

There are talented sculptors, oilmen and fire-fighters who contribute mightily to society with this placement.

But, if you know a Mars in SCORPIO individual, don't make an enemy of them! The vengeful wrath that can be heaped on those who cross them is unmistakable!

Consider yourself warned.

Or, if you have Mars in SCORPIO in your own chart, consider yourself unmasked.

Jupiter in SCORPIO gives fervency to the studies of philosophy and religion.

There can be seen a dogmatic adherence to philosophic beliefs and religious faith. Some infer from this that the SCORPIO bodily appetites can be surmounted or forced into a higher expression.

Perhaps.

But, just as likely, this religious or philosophical fervency can be twisted into conforming to the enormous physical needs inherent in the sign SCORPIO.

Much the same can be said whenever Jupiter forms a relationship with Pluto in the horoscope.

No placement feels the guilt and shame for their sexual exploits quite like Saturn placed in SCORPIO. Maybe, they have already paid the price of infertility, or a chronic STD.

Saturn will take you to task for hasty actions. SCORPIO only makes haste in the bedroom.

Sounds like a combination for disaster to me.

Uranus can unleash some of its enormous energy when in SCORPIO. We only have to look back about thirty years (1975-1982) to see the results of Uranian force in the sign SCORPIO.

HIV AIDS was first identified by the U.S. Center for Disease Control in 1981. This disease was existent for some time but the Uranian transit through SCORPIO blew the lid off the complex set of symptoms besetting Health Professionals worldwide.

Neptune's most recent sensual tryst with SCORPIO was during the late 1950's through the 1960's. The seeds of free love were sprouting everywhere.

The legitimatization of what had previously been labeled "sexual promiscuity" occurred during this time. An antiseptic form of Sex Education began to be taught in public schools.

Sagittarius

If their hair is long enough, they will pull it back into a pony tail. The obvious reference to horses is due to the symbol for SAGITTARIUS, the Centaur. The Centaur is known throughout Greek Mythology as being half human and half horse.

Like the Centaur, these beings are said to be caught between two natures (they are "liminal"). They have an animal-like instinct that keeps them from harm's way and human foresight to envision a crisis before it arises.

Since Jupiter takes about twelve years to go through all twelve signs, these are the one in twelve people that get most of life's "lucky" breaks.

Saturn in SAGITTARIUS steadies the mind. People with this combination should become paid dissertation writers. They can hold onto all the facts, and blend them into a lengthy discourse.

Their excellent mastery of difficult subject matter enables them to rise to the top position at prestigious Colleges and Universities. This isn't so much through luck as wisdom. They know how to acquire knowledge and pass some of their methods on to their fortunate faculty.

A significantly placed Saturn in SAGITTARIUS in the birth chart endows one with a studious wisdom.

We witnessed Uranus in SAGITTARIUS during much of the 1980's. The University culture underwent tumultuous changes during this period. We also witnessed the beginning of widespread gambling casinos in this country.

Major cultural changes were beginning to surface as some Pastors and Priests were exposed as shills and predators. Western Religions weren't prepared for the explosive attack Uranus in SAGITTARIUS made to bring the issues before the public.

Neptune sidled into SAGITTARIUS in January of 1970. Those readers old enough to remember this fourteen-year cycle, recall some the headlines. The ones which I use to blend the meaning of the planet Neptune aligned with the sign SAGITTARIUS are in connection with narcotic smuggling into the USA from foreign countries, and the dilution of the Liberal Arts education in higher institutions of learning.

Those two citations are examples of blending the powerful forces of Pluto with the world wide scope of SAGITTARIUS.

As the Sun enters CAPRICORN, Mother Nature is laying a blanket of snow over the perennial gardens and lawns, affording them protection from the blustery winds. In the shops, much preparation is going on to celebrate the Christian feast of Christmas.

CAPRICORNS delights in this season. Their merriment is derived from the upswing in sales their businesses have at this time.

CAPRICORN is the business owner. They are willing to put in the hard work necessary to build an enterprise into a veritable cash cow. CAPRICORN Sun keeps their attention focused on the bottom line and this holiday season never fails to improve their profit.

Turning to the Mercury in CAPRICORN placement, we see these natives burning the midnight oil to get the top score on their exams.

Mercury is quite competitive when in CAPRICORN. If they get top scores, doors will open for them to the more prestigious business schools. They envision obtaining their MBA in record time and going on to learn and earn with a few major corporations.

But, the end game revolves around owning the company. And, because of their tireless efforts, and continual attention to details, their dream is often realized.

Venus turns oddly practical when she inhabits CAPRICORN. Her youthful profile would allow her to wear the styles seen on teens and young adults well into retirement.

But, she has an eye for more classic styles that can be worn year after year. She has a coat and two jackets that her father wore when he was in the Navy.

She interchanges them with a brown cashmere ankle length coat and some woolen blazers she's picked up over time when she found them on sale.

On the practical side (and this lady is all matter-of-fact), she is seeing a well-known owner of a popular cosmetic company. In confidence, she relates to her best friend that she will hang on to him until something better comes along.

Mars ploughs into CAPRICORN on his John Deere tractor. He's ready for the hard work ahead.

Perseverance is his middle name. He's ready to do the heavy-lifting any complex job may require.

His endurance is often legendary. This comes in handy when pursuing the object of his desires as well. He belongs to the "first to come, last to leave" school of winning his mate. He never fails to please his lovers, because of his patience and endurance.

Someone once said that Jupiter in CAPRICORN is an oxymoron; Jupiter being the symbol for sheer luck and CAPRICORN displaying the hallmark of hard work.

I prefer to try to blend the qualities. But, I've been disappointed more than a few times with this combination. Their fathers usually have put in all the hard work and these natives bask in the reflected glory from the previous generation.

These are the individuals who get the job because the higher-ups know his dad or the family name sweeps him back into elected office year after year, without him doing much in the here and now to deserve his reelection.

They also have access to private sources of financing and country club memberships based solely on the reputation of their elders.

As they age, this can turn into "tough luck" if these folks never become accomplished on their own.

In CAPRICORN, Saturn is at home. He feels the inhibitive influence as a blanket that keeps him safe from getting too chummy with success.

He knows he has to continue to struggle just so he will maintain his out-infront position, and he's no stranger to long hours and grinding drudgery.

If this is what it takes to keep him at the top of his profession, he's more than willing to make the sacrifice. This placement exhibits hard work par excellence. The rewards do come for these persevering natives. But, never confuse their rise to prominence with luck!

It's been a back-breaking fight the whole way.

Uranus was in CAPRICORN most recently from February 1988 to January 1996. Big business, symbolized by CAPRICORN, underwent a total upheaval. In this country, it was a time when business executives were beginning to resent the fatherly role they had played in their employees' careers. Labor contracts were being rewritten to continually favor management. Employees were starting to be hired on under new terms.

This thread will continue when we explore Pluto below.

Neptune sort of tunneled into CAPRICORN. We can call this 14 year period, "the era of the Whistle Blower". People who had worked for decades for large government agencies and huge corporations were hypnotized into believing that, by exposing their insider horror stories, the climate in their agency/corporation would improve.

As with most misguided efforts Neptune makes, these folks suffered many disappointments. Neptune can't get its head around facts and figures. So, through the latter part of the 1980's into the 1990's, when Neptune inhabited CAPRICORN, corporations and agencies viewed it as business as usual, but with a few more crybabies.

Presently, Pluto is occupying the sign CAPRICORN. If you like the way big business and government agencies handled the foregoing transits of Uranus and Neptune through CAPRICORN, you're gonna love this transit.

Pluto brings organized labor into the picture in an unflattering pose. There is little doubt that Corporations and Government agencies, symbolized by CAPRICORN, can remain unchanged by the relentless and underhanded assault of Pluto.

Pluto sometimes decides to destroy what it can't modify.



Aquarius

Oh, look! Our Moon has drifted into AQUARIUS. Here he/she is sitting at the kitchen table with his/her foot propped up.

Wouldn't you know it, just when he/she had all the preparation ahead of him/her for the family invasion he/she went jogging to energize himself/herself and stepped on a rock and twisted his/her ankle.

Some of his/her friends from the skiing club are on their way over to put the whole meal together.

You get the message, Moon in AQUARIUS is certain that there are no male or female roles. The whole scene would be bad enough without this ankle injury.

Brother Tom is constantly harping about the unusual lifestyle she's chosen. And, little sister Peggy just wants her to settle down and be happy. Moon in AQUARIUS is very happy! This amazes onlookers.

When the sun moves into AQUARIUS, there is a ray of hope. There has been enough water through the winter to maintain the heavy root systems and underground springs. Chilly breezes clear away the excess moisture above the ground, maintaining the balance of earth to water.

Those with the Sun in AQUARIUS should be aware that their sign sits between the very earthy Capricorn and the extremely watery Pisces.

Their job is to maintain the equilibrium of water to earth. Symbolically, this refers to their ability to weigh emotions (water) with practicality (earth).

AQUARIUS is the most rational of the twelve signs.

Mercury is most pleased to enter the realm of AQUARIUS. This placement personifies the thought process and learning at its most lucid.

Move to the head of the class, Mercury in AQUARIUS.

Much of the above applies to natives with a close association of Mercury with Uranus in their birth chart.

"Throw away the make-up, uplift bra, tummy minimizer and razor. I'm fine the way I was created!" Now ladies, I know this sounds so *extreme*, but not to the Venus in AQUARIUS. Luckily, they are usually born with above average bone structure and sturdy hair and nails.

There is no real department they can shop in at the chain stores and big outlet malls. They are found rummaging through the second-hand shops hopping from men's racks to ladies without giving it a thought. The end result is eclectic and highly unique.

If you find Venus in the horoscope configured with the planet Uranus, some of the same tendencies will apply.

You ask about their love life. Much of the foregoing applies there as well.

Live and let live is the Venus in AQUARIUS mantra.

Mars in AQUARIUS zips into his assigned parking place at the Automotive Design and Assembly plant in his Mitsubishi's Prototype X. He was instrumental in the design and changes to the turbocharged 2.0-liter four-cylinder engine.

His dual talents as a mechanical designer and automotive engineer have made his present position possible.

Mental energy consumes these natives.

Presently, he's working on a more advanced concept car to be debuted at the Detroit Auto Show next year. He appears so laid back, no one would fathom the genius that inhabits his brain.

Here in AQUARIUS, Jupiter applies its luck very even-handedly. Much of the good fortune that can befall Jupiter in AQUARIUS is due to sudden unexpected events:

- \$ A chance whim to pick up a lottery ticket.
- **\$** A sudden offer to travel that turns into a great adventure.
- **\$** Approval for a research project that allows a stipend and all expenses until the completion of the study.

The close association AQUARIUS has with Uranus brings about the same type of events when Jupiter is aligned in the birth chart with Uranus. This is often referred to as the "lucky break" aspect.

With the placement of Saturn in AQUARIUS, there is still the tendency to be able to make major breakthroughs in science, medicine and engineering. But, as is always the case with Saturn, much hard work goes before the brilliantly conceived invention.

Saturn in Aquarius may be the ideal placement. The arduous labor of Saturn combined with the brilliant, inquiring mind of AQUARIUS, is hard to beat in making new discoveries in most fields of endeavor.

In AQUARIUS, Uranus finds its home. The planet's erratic orbit and the blending of the water and the earth into a rational form, bring about the dramatic changes that accompany truly innovative discoveries.

We have recently experienced seven years of Uranus in AQUARIUS. During that period, science and technology have aligned their forces for changing

medicine, automobiles and communications to a degree never conceived of as possible.

Change was everywhere in the wind.

Neptune is presently domiciled in AQUARIUS; possibly blurring some of the dramatic discoveries noted earlier when Uranus was in AQUARIUS. As Neptune takes roughly fourteen years to transverse each sign, it may be late 2010 before some of the most remarkable innovations inspired during Uranus' transit through AQUARIUS will come out of the clouds and descend into the worldly realm where they can be put to practical, everyday use.

We will see Pluto in AQUARIUS after it finishes its tour of Capricorn. In theory, this will be the uncovering of long range consequences and unimagined results of previous medical and scientific discoveries. This process will begin during late 2023.

Some of the more brilliant inventions may be smashed to smithereens or monopolized by large corporate or underworld interests. Those with an eye to prediction may be able to reach back in history to find some clues even though it hasn't transited this revolutionary sign since Pluto's discovery in 1930.



Pisces

Back on the Moon, she has moved into watery PISCES. These family gatherings are always so filled with emotion.

The Moon can remember previous reunions where there were hurt feelings and disappointments.

Everyone has agreed to bring a dish; our Moon in Pisces is providing the beverages. She always has a couple cases of vintage wines put away for special occasions.

The bar is stocked to provide martinis, cosmopolitans and other mixed drinks.

Moon in Pisces very much hopes her younger brother can attend. He was just released from the penitentiary after serving time for drug-related charges, and it's time he put his life back together.

One year, he couldn't make this annual event because he was hospitalized after an overdose.

She dreamily concludes that this year will be better.

When the Sun rolls into PISCES, there seems to be a lot of fog and haze.

The Sun is not very powerful here. The only bright spot seems to be the

Irish High Holy Day; the Feast of St. Patrick. It's as if the sojourn of the Sun

through late February and March needs a little repast to be able to continue on until Spring.

Natives of PISCES go with the flow. We see them trudging on through the snow flakes and mud puddles to reach their destination.

No other sign can appreciate the special difficulties they experience.

Sun in PISCES is the most sensitive of the twelve Sun placements. They have absorbed the disappointment and discouragement of all the previous signs. They earned their reputation as martyrs.

When Mercury is positioned in PISCES, there can be a poetic mind. Mercury in PISCES learns by osmosis. They soak up only what is needed, all the while having their rich imaginations off dreaming about more important subjects.

The sign PISCES is represented by two fish swimming in opposite directions. Think double majors; one in the social sciences and one in hospital management.

Thoughts seem to come to them out "out of the blue". This enhances their psychic abilities. This will also be true of persons who have a strong connection between Mercury and Neptune in their natal charts.

The aging Queen; not what she once was, but still beautiful is, symbolically, Venus in PISCES. Little flaws are showing up. Maybe, a small tear is present in the fabric of beauty they are clothed in. Estee Lauder and Lancôme' are much the wealthier for Venus visiting PISCES, as are the Cosmetic Surgeons. These ladies and gentlemen maintain their beauty well beyond its natural limits.

Romantically, we see Venus in PISCES dating younger people to prolong their own youth.

They see the beauty in one rose, rather than the dozen expected by others.

They are so flattered to still be wanted and appreciated.

We can call Venus in PISCES: "Love on the high seas".

As Mars paddles into PISCES, his canoe is taking on water. Quick movements will cause the boat to tip. If they can't get to shore and end this journey soon, they will drown.

Mars in PISCES can handle more than one task at a time e.g. bailing out water and paddling. But, don't expect this to go on forever. They do tire.

Their talent for empathy is put to good use as healers and social workers. They really do "Feel your Pain".

If Mars in the birth chart has challenges from outer planets (Uranus, Neptune and Pluto), they can become the victims of society.

Mars in PISCES also has an ability to work with all matter of prostheses.

Jupiter in PISCES is wonderfully placed. Every twelve years, when Jupiter travels through PISCES, the fish seem to find their way a little closer to land. PICEANS are a bit more outgoing, they are better talkers and socializers during Jupiter's reign of their Sun sign.

Those born with Jupiter in PISCES have been known to amass fortunes in the hospital and institutional industries. They also have a knack for buying stock in the adult beverage sector and living their lifetime on the dividends.

Before the discovery of Neptune, Jupiter was happily at home in PISCES. There is still a pleasant relationship when Jupiter and Neptune meet in the natal horoscope.

We look in on the prison cell that can be Saturn in PISCES, to see through the bars someone paying dearly for their emotional outbursts, drug dependencies or perhaps an alcoholic "lost weekend".

More than most Saturn placements, these natives need to keep their feelings and cravings under control. One wrong step and their downfall can be devastating.

If Saturn in Pisces is *the* prominent feature of a horoscope, there can be a lifelong battle with drug dependency, alcoholism or petty crimes.

Presently, Uranus is domiciled in PISCES. So far, there has been a tendency on the part of local and state governments to privatize some of the largely heretofore public institutions and services. Prison systems, hospitals and even garbage collection have been jobbed out to the private sector.

Since these functions don't lend themselves naturally to the "for profit" system, these will probably not be seen as a major economic boom in the future.

Neptune has finally come home to rest as it enters PISCES. This will be in March of 2011. We will probably see a comprehensive, compassionate health care system at this time.

It will move in slowly, with a few fits and starts, but the time will have come for this reform. The true cost will, of course, be quite murky. This is how Neptune operates.

Perhaps, oil profits will be subjugated into paying for this elaborate entitlement scheme. Pure conjecture, but nonetheless quite possible with Neptune in PISCES.

Pluto in PISCES will usher in the discovery of corruption and monopolization in the same fields that were overturned and reformed with Uranus and Neptune's travels through PISCES. Prisons, Drug Rehabilitation facilities, hospitals and some other public service institutions will be found to have been dominated by unsavory criminal types of the same ilk that are presently occupying large government and corporate circles. Pluto destroys what can't be totally reorganized.

But, this is very far into the future.

Chapter Three: The Aspects - The Direction the Road Takes

Each planet in the horoscope has a relationship with the others. Since the horoscope is composed of three hundred and sixty degrees with each sign occupying thirty of these degrees, the combinations of relationships that can be formed are myriad.

This Chapter will deal with only the major geometric angles.

For a key to understanding the aspects, an appreciation of the elements and modes is probably required.

The four elements are fire, earth, air and water.

The modes consist of cardinal, fixed and mutable.

The first sign, Aries, is of the Fire element and Cardinal mode.

The second sign, Taurus, is Earth and Fixed.

The third sign, Gemini, is Air and Mutable.

The fourth sign, Cancer, is Water and again Cardinal.

.... and so it goes

Leo, Fire, Fixed.

Virgo, Earth, Mutable.

Libra, Air, Cardinal.

Scorpio, Water, Fixed.

Sagittarius, Fire, Mutable.

Capricorn, Earth, Cardinal.

Pisces, Water, Mutable.

The Fire signs are hot and energetic.

The Earth signs are down to earth and practical.

The Air Signs are intellectual. The Water signs are emotion based.

The Cardinal mode initiates action, the Fixed mode carries through the initial action, and the Mutable mode adapts to the actions initiated and carried through by the Cardinal and Fixed modes.

Conjunction

Conjunction: When planets are within ten degrees of one another, they are said to be in CONJUNCTION to one another.

This happens a good deal of the time when the planets are both in the same sign. But, even when they are in adjoining signs, the flavor of one is carried over into the other, just like foods that are next to each other in the refrigerator.

The stronger planet will usually impart a greater flavor on the weaker planet.

The planets are viewed as strong when in their own signs or in a sign in which they are comfortable.

Conversely, they are thought to be weak when in a sign in which they aren't as compatible.

For example: The Sun in Leo is very powerful; it can usually dominate any planets near to it. The influence of the Leonine Sun can bring its natural brilliance to any other planet it touches.

The tendency to outshine that the Sun possess must be factored into the interpretation of the Sun when it's conjunct with the other planets.

Conversely, with conjunctions to the Moon, the flavor of the planets mostly spill over onto the Moon rather than the other way around.

Sextile

Sextile: When planets are sixty degrees apart, they are said to be in sextile aspect.

There is what is called an orb of influence of five or six degrees, so that planets which are anywhere between fifty-four and sixty-six degrees of each other will have this harmonious blending.

The relationship is an easy one.

Although the Elements and modes aren't the same, they are in harmony.

There is not the sharing of flavors associated with the Conjunction but a blending of the dispositions of the two planets.

It signals an opportunity for these two planets to work well together. If these planets are two signs apart, this is also a signal that this easy compatibility is present.

For our example, we will use the Moon in Cancer and Venus in Taurus. Both are at home in their own signs and blending these two gives a love of the home and opportunities to "feather one's nest" with much luxury.

This is a distinctly agreeable mixture.

Square

Square: This ninety-degree angle has some sharp edges. As a planet attempts to exert its energy, there is a road block in the form of the planet in a ninety degree relationship to it.

These two planets are struggling for dominance because they are both of the same Mode. The stronger the planet is by sign or element, the more likely it is to win the contest between these two disagreeing forces.

For example, Mars in Aries is in its own sign and element, ninety degrees away from Venus in Capricorn.

Here, with Mars at home and Venus not in an entirely compatible sign, Mars wins.

The natural tendency of Venus to placate and soften is stifled by the forceful nature of Mars. Ninety degree angles are fraught with difficulty until a method of using this challenging aspect is formulated by the native. The orb of influence for this aspect can be as much as eight degrees to include all planets that are from eighty-two to ninety-eight degrees apart.

Trine

Trine: When two planets form an angle one hundred and twenty degrees apart, they are said to trine one another. These are auspicious angles.

Since both planets will usually be found in the same element; either fire, water, air or earth, the qualities of both planets dance to the same tune.

But, even if it is found that the elements are different (called an out of sign trine), the energies can blend because the degree formed will always produce harmonious vibrations at the very least.

For example: Jupiter in Sagittarius trine Uranus in Leo. The natural enthusiasm and good-heartedness of Jupiter in Sagittarius will bring out the brilliant shine of the Uranus in Leo.

These aspects have an orb of about eight degrees, so that anywhere from one hundred and twelve to one hundred and twenty eight degrees separating two planets will give them a familiar compatibility with one another.

Opposition

Opposition: The OPPOSITION aspect is like members of warring armies facing one another in battle; someone has to lose.

Since both planets are in the same mode, causing a challenge, we will look to the planet which is stronger by element or sign to dominate this pairing.

If both are equally powerful, a lifetime battle may ensue. For example; the Moon in Cancer OPPOSITE Saturn in Capricorn: The war can be found at first with the parents and, later on, in the natives own relationships. Since these planets usually represent contradictory principles, some compromising of basic principles is necessary to overcome this challenging face off.

This is true in any Moon/Saturn OPPOSITON regardless of the signs in which they are placed.

The orb for the OPPOSITION aspect is ten degrees, so that any planet one hundred and seventy to one hundred and ninety degrees away from another will be in OPPOSITON aspect to it.

Inconjunct

Inconjunct: The INCONJUNCT aspect is formed by two planets one-hundred and fifty degrees apart. These planets are usually not in the same element or mode.

There is little which these two have in common. But, the angle is a powerful one so they attempt to get along.

Many adjustments must be made in their innate way of expressing themselves.

For example; the Moon in Watery Pisces INCONJUNCT Neptune in Airy Libra. This combination causes the emotional, shy Moon to adapt to the relationship oriented, more intellectual Libra Neptune.

The adjustment might go something like this: A shy, rather introverted native is compelled to interact with a large social club in order to participate in the Poetry Study Club and Drama Group that will fulfill the fantasies of the Piscean Moon and the need to be in the company of the socializing Neptune in Libra.

Since Neptune and Pisces are related, there is a common bond that can be formed. With the INCONJUNCT, some adjustment to inherent traits is required.

Allow a narrow 2-3 degree orb for this aspect.

Mutual Reception

Mutual Reception: This is the only other relationship being covered here. It is not necessarily an aspect, as seen above, although it can be.

The basis for the relationship with the two planets involved here is because they are each positioned in the other's home sign.

For example: Venus in Virgo and Mercury in Libra. This happens quite often to Virgo and Libra natives. Think of it as switching apartments. Venus moves into Mercury's flat or vice versa.


With such auspicious relationships, Venus can take on her own qualities as well as the qualities of Mercury and the same goes for Mercury.

This particular MUTUAL RECEPTION of Venus to Mercury is prominent in the charts of clothing designers and antique dealers. I also noted it in the chart of a popular writer of romantic novels. Both planets seem to be able to bring out the best in each other.

Chapter Four: The Houses - Every Road Leads Somewhere

This chart is generated by the AstroDeluxe Program provided by:

HALLORAN SOFTWARE



As you examine the chart, notice that the inner circle of the horoscope is numbered. These numbers are from one at the east point all the way around to twelve at the point just above the east point.

Each of the twelve houses symbolically corresponds to an area of life.

Since everyone has questions concerning specific issues in life, once the chart is constructed, you look to the house that best fits the question.

Below are a few of the more common issues that concern us all and the house that we reference when looking for guidance with these issues.

HOUSE ONE: The first house relates to the planet Mars and to the Sign Aries.

This is where we look for clues to the physical appearance. In addition, we see here the impression we make on others. The sign occupying this house is called your Ascendant or rising sign. This is the sign and degree on the eastern horizon as you are born. Here is where we say, "This is me!"

HOUSE TWO: The Second House relates to the Planet Venus and to the sign Taurus.

This house corresponds to our resources. Whether it's our values or the money we can earn. Lots of planets located here can bog down the native with "stuff". But it can also make you rich! Here's where we say "This is what I possess."

HOUSE THREE: The Third House relates to the planet Mercury and to the Sign Gemini.

House Three reflects our surroundings, whether it's the brothers and sisters we grow up surrounded by or the neighborhood we live in. It also shows the area of local travel and the modes we use to get from place to place. The third house also indicates what we learn in our formative years. Here's where we say, "This is what surrounds me, this is what I know for sure."

HOUSE FOUR: The Fourth House relates to the Moon and to the Sign Cancer.

This house very closely vibrates to our own home, our mother or father, and to our final resting place. The fourth house shows where we come from and where we will end up. Here's where we say "I belong or I will belong."

HOUSE FIVE: The Fifth House relates to the Sun and to the sign Leo.

This house represents the fun we will have. Also, and perhaps you might think conversely, our children. No one has more fun than children! This is where romantic relationships are taken lightly, for the fun they may bring. Love affairs on the spur of the moment, just for fun will show up in this house also. Here we say "I enjoy!"

HOUSE SIX: The Sixth House relates to the Planet Mercury and to the sign Virgo.

This is the house that can closely reflect our health. It relates also to everyday chores and jobs we have to take on. There's a lot of work to be done when we enter the Sixth house. Not much fun here! In this house the phrase most spoken is "I'll do my job, even if it makes me sick!"

HOUSE SEVEN: The Seventh House relates to the Planet Venus and to the Sign Libra.

House seven most closely reflects the partners we take on in life, whether they are business or marital. Relationships are formed by this house. Curiously, we can also look to this area for a clue to the enemies we have. Probably, this is because the seventh house opposes the first house of our own physical body. Here we say "These are the people I take seriously."

HOUSE EIGHT: The Eighth House relates to the Planet Pluto and to the sign Scorpio.

This house exposes the resources of others - the ones which we may inherit, enjoy, use, exploit or manage. This house is distinct from the second house where we tout our own resources. The polarity of the second house to the eighth puts into mind the difference between what we have and what we need. The eighth house sheds light on our needs. Here we say "I desire."

THE NINTH HOUSE: The Ninth House relates to the Planet Jupiter and to the Sign Sagittarius.

This house shows how we see world, the big picture. Here is where our philosophy or guiding religious principles live. Here we also see the major trips we may take, both mentally and physically. Some reference to in-laws is also seen because this is symbolically our partner's house of brothers and sisters. (Third house from the seventh.) Here we say "This is what I've learned from others and from my own further studies."

THE TENTH HOUSE: The Tenth House relates to the Planet Saturn and to the Sign Capricorn.

The career is on display here. Where we belong (the Fourth House) sends us upward to find what we can fit into it in the outer world. This is also referred to the Midheaven. This sign and degree are directly overhead when you are born. The planets in this house as well as the sign occupying this house cusp tell us a lot about what we can expect from our life's work. It also says what is expected from us, so there is this insinuation of the bosses we have as well as how we can perform as the boss. Here we say, "I've accomplished."

THE ELEVENTH HOUSE: The Eleventh House relates to the Planet Uranus and to the Sign Aquarius.

In the Eleventh House, we can see what our career has done for us. The acquaintances we've made, the associations we belong to, but also the hopes and wishes we've seen materialized from the efforts of our career. This house very much says, "These are the trappings of my efforts in the world."

THE TWELFTH HOUSE: The Twelfth House relates to the Planet Neptune and to the Sign Pisces.

We are not home free just yet! This is the house of our undoing. All of the other eleven houses can come undone here. Here is where we can see the possibility for incarceration or institutionalization. Here is where we house our biggest disappointments. Our mantra here is "I'm disillusioned, I'm sorry."

Using the Houses of the Horoscope, we can introduce the planets, the signs they are in and any aspect these planets have, into an area of our life that are by them.

In the next chapter, we look at the ways we can interpret the houses, aspect, planets and signs in the birth chart.

Chapter Five: The Complete Itinerary

Earlier in the book, there is <u>a chart</u> drawn up for Mother's Day, 2008 at 12:45 pm EDT, in North Olmsted, Ohio. This is the birth chart of that moment.

Any person born that day, at that time and in that location, would have that chart as their own birth HOROSCOPE.

For the purpose of demonstration, we'll call this person Joe.

Using the previous chapters, let's see how we can describe "Joe's" chart.

We see Leo in the First House, on the Ascendant. We know Leo does things in a grand manner and likes to have fun.

Then, we notice the planet Saturn tucked down into the First house in the sign Virgo. This will probably make the fun loving Leo rising know when to put the brakes on.

Because Saturn occupies the same sign that is found on the Second house of resources, "Joe" may not have the money to throw around that Leo would like.

With conscientious Virgo on the Second House cusp, Joe lives on a strict budget.

With Libra on the third house cusp, Joe has an expensive car to keep up and many occasions for pleasant visits with his siblings.

He was stylishly dressed when he went to school and usually had many friends.

He probably lived in the "right" neighborhood and spent many enjoyable times with his school friends.

On the Fourth house is Scorpio; these are his parents, at least the more dominant one. Joe's Mother was always suspicious of the time he spent away from home during his teenage years. She would have liked it better if he had spent more time doing his research and study papers. She also pressured him into obtaining as much financial aid as possible, and did a

thorough job of investigating where he could obtain the most grants. She also thought his lab and study partners were taking advantage of his generous sharing of information. She felt they may be exploiting his knowledge for their own benefit.

They lived on the lower floor of a stately duplex very near the lake. Her mother inherited the home from her own parents.

With Sagittarius on the Fifth House cusp, and Pluto positioned there, we see that Joe has a lot of romantic relationships, but none of them seem to run smoothly.

His romantic interests usually are jealous and possessive. He loves to gamble, but he is certain that there are underworld criminals skimming from the casino he goes to, so he is careful to take only the amount of money he can spare and cashes out and leaves when he hits a big pot.

Joe has Capricorn on his Sixth House; he is a tirelessly hard worker. With Jupiter so close to the cusp of this house, we know he probably enjoys working harder than anyone else. Jupiter here can also tell us that he is blessed with good health.

The only issues he should encounter with this placement have to do with over-indulgence.

With Aquarius on the Seventh House, we can infer that his marriage was sudden, probably unexpected, and went through many changes before it finally ended in divorce.

Neptune in the seventh suggests a foggy, idealized image of the marriage partner. Or, perhaps, the marriage partner was addicted to alcohol or drugs.

Let's see if this Neptune receives any difficult aspects.

We see a close square to it from the Sun. This marriage would involve some image issues for Joe. He probably felt he would get further in his career (Sun placed in the tenth house) without this addicted spouse.

His boss may have privately mentioned to him that she noticed his wife was intoxicated at the company Christmas party.

His Eighth House has Pisces on the cusp. Presently, his mother intends to leave her considerable estate to the Animal Sanctuary. Pisces causes much frustration where it falls in the chart. With Uranus held firmly in this house, she could suddenly become incompetent leaving the decisions regarding her estate to him.

This is only a possibility. Her entire fortune could be invested in Nuclear Power Facilities, and boom or bust on a turn of the market.

I would predict the unpredictable where Uranus occupies and tell him to keep investing in his own 401K and Employee Savings Plan.

Uranus in the Eighth House *can* signify a financial windfall, but don't run to the bank just yet!

Aries on the cusp of the Ninth house shows that Joe tried to excel in college. He won some awards. He was quick to grasp at a chance for some study opportunities in Germany, and wants to return there someday for a vacation.

He has cut ties with the church he belonged to while he was growing up. His philosophy is quite terse: "Live and Let Live."

As we move on to the Tenth House of Career and reputation, with Taurus on the cusp of this house, we think he may be involved in banking.

Venus posited here in her own sign, Taurus, bodes well for his income and further suggests banking.

With Venus here it is also possible that a woman is instrumental in furthering his career. He tells us that the female president and CEO took him under her wing and has been grooming him for a spot that will be opening on the Board of Directors.

Joe also has the Sun in the Tenth house. Where you find the Sun is a likely place for the native to shine. Joe is optimistic about this for his career.

We also see Mercury situated well into the Tenth House closing in on the cusp of House Eleven. We might infer from this that he speaks before clubs and organizations regarding banking regulations and policies. Even though Joe

started into the banking field in a relatively low position, (he began as an Assistant Branch Manager), he will rise to prominence in this field.

With Gemini on the Eleventh House cusp, Joe has a membership in a discussion club. This is a neighborhood group that meets monthly at the local recreation center. The topics for discussion revolve around betterment of the Community.

Joe wishes to write manuals for the banking community. He has stated that he needs to get down on paper all the speeches he has delivered regarding his profession.

With Cancer on the Twelfth House of disappointments and undoing, Joe knows that his fondness for keeping his emotions hidden has tripped him up a few times.

He would probably be better served by telling his mother about his frustration and hurt over her choice of endowing the Animal Shelter when she dies, but these emotions are kept hidden and bottled up.

Mars located in the Twelfth House says he may hold in his anger even when he would be better served by releasing some of it. His penchant for keeping his feelings under wraps could very well be his undoing.

The wide Moon/Neptune Opposition reinforces this tendency. With the Moon placed so close to the Ascendant, he really is not fooling anyone about all the emotions he experiences.

The Moon on the Ascendant tends to wear their heart on their sleeve.

Moreover, one massive emotional outburst may be quite overwhelming to those around him. We want to warn him to express his feelings as they arise, since everyone is already aware of them.

Maybe, if he does this, he can avoid the melt-down or crack-up he is headed for if he continues this repressive stance.

The interpretation given above is just an example of how a person may interact with their horoscope.

The possibilities are endless.

Astrology in general, and the Horoscope in particular, are symbolic representations; they are a language we can make use of in order to grasp our earthly position.

In the next few chapters, we will use the same horoscope chart to illustrate very different circumstances.

By using the symbolic language of Astrology, we open a door to understanding that we previously didn't know existed.

Chapter Six: Synastry – People We Meet Along the Road

Synastry is the branch of Astrology that can tell us about our compatibility with the people in our life.

Occasionally, Synastry is used to see how people relate to an organization or even a country. But, for now, we will just explore personal relationships.

Again, we will be using the <u>example chart shown here</u>.

Joe wants to know about the twelve other people in his Discussion Group. He has not pried into their personal lives enough to know their exact dates, times or location of their birth, but he would like to find out if he should form a more personal relationship with any of them.

Oddly enough, and strictly for our purposes, there is represented in this group one member of each of the twelve signs of the Zodiac.

Because all we have at our disposal is these folks' Sun Signs, we will place their Suns into Joe's chart and look for relationships to his planetary set-up.

First, naturally, is Agnes Aries. Her Sun falls in his Ninth house. This can mean that she resonates to his "Live and Let Live" philosophy. She has mentioned that she wants to visit Germany and look up some of her ancestors.

Her Sun in Aries makes a trine aspect to his behind-the-scenes Moon in Leo. The trine is a very favorable aspect according to the chapter you read on Aspects. The Sun and Moon are vital to creating relationships. The warm energies flowing between her Sun in Aries and his Moon in Leo make this one of the club members with whom he is most interested in forming a more personal relationship.

Without knowing anything else about her chart, we can infer from this Sun/Moon trine that he and Agnes Aries will both have an interest in developing at least a friendship.

Next is Tim Taurus. He and Joe have similar views on the neighborhood beautification project and both have expressed concerns about how to acquire the budget to cover the expenses for this mission. But, they tend to compete for floor-time in airing their opinions, and they both have some difficulty seeing the others' stubbornly held points of view. Joe thinks they can see eye-to-eye long enough to complete the plans of the group, but Joe also sees Tim Taurus as a rival.

He seems to have many of the same qualities that Joe has and does not really add much to Joe's already easygoing, soft-spoken personality. Here, we are witnessing the Conjunction of the two Suns. There is the tendency with this inter-chart aspect to try to "outshine" each other, to "block out each other's rays" so to speak.

Maybe this would be like having two left feet. It may be reassuring to see that there is another one a good deal like it, but is it very useful?

Joe sees very little possibility for furthering this contact.

Gina Gemini has sparked Joe's interest. She is always there to fill in any lulls in the conversations the group may be having.

Her Sun is Conjunct Joe's Mercury in Gemini. She relates to his ideas about the need to spruce things up in the downtown sector. She generally votes his way on the issues presented before the group.

However, because her Sun in Gemini Squares his Uranus in Pisces, he sees a disturbing trend in her attitudes about the budget they have to work with.

She is more inclined to look for Federal Grant money. This would give the group more money. However, in Joe's eyes, they would then have the Federal Government dictating the development of their community.

Gina has quite a perky attitude and perhaps under different circumstances he may be interested in furthering this relationship.

Her Sun makes a Sextile Aspect to his Moon in Leo. There is the opportunity for a harmonious relationship but with Gina's Sun square Joe's Uranus, there would be the obstacle of her challenging (Square) any need he may feel for independence (Uranus).

Christopher Cancer appeared to be a welcome addition to the group. (His Sun Sextiles Joe's Sun). His family has been in this community for four generations.

However, because his Sun falls into Joe's Twelfth House, Joe sees him as frustrating and a disappointment.

Christopher Cancer wants everything to remain as it is. The only changes he would consider would be restoring historic landmarks and returning the inner ring of the downtown sector into a Promenade, like it was years ago.

Because Christopher's Sun makes an opposition to Joe's Jupiter, Joe thinks he would squander the entire budget on making the city more of what it already is.

When arguments surface in the group, Christopher gets moody and emotional and will retreat from all further discussion.

If Joe is lucky, he will be able to tolerate Christopher in the meetings, but Joe wishes no expansion of this troublesome relationship.

Lucy Leo heads up their entertainment committee. She does superbly.

She makes sure that Joe always has center stage when they perform their yearly benefit concert. With Lucy's Sun conjunct Joe's Moon and Ascendant, they are forever seeking each other out. They will usually stop for a drink together after the meetings.

Lucy usually has a few too many cocktails (her Sun is opposite Joe's Neptune) and Joe has taken her home more than once.

He has driven her to her door and watched her from his car window to make sure she was able to get into the house, and then he pulls way.

Nevertheless, because of her Leo Sun squaring his Tenth House Sun and Venus and opposing his Neptune, there has been a lot of gossip going around that they are having an affair. Neither Joe nor Lucy would particularly object to this happening; with her Sun also making a sextile aspect to his Mercury, they always communicate agreeably.

Lucy is definitely on his radar screen.

Vic Virgo is Chairman of the "<u>Clean Up Our Community"</u> Subcommittee. He also takes on the duties of Purchasing and Sub-Contracting. This group would not function without his tireless efforts.

His Sun in Opposition aspect to Joe's Uranus may cause Joe to see him as a bit odd, but quite unique in his opinions. This opposition aspect can mean that they are unable to agree on how to use the public property and the funds donated to the group.

With Vic's Sun trine Joe's Pluto, Vic has suggested that, if they were more closely aligned (perhaps by charter) with the City Government, they could make use of eminent domain legislation to claim and demolish the unsightly, mostly abandoned buildings that tower over the downtown district.

Since Joe's Taurus Sun and Vic' Virgo Sun trine one another, these disagreements are usually smoothed over with most of the committee siding with Joe.

This relationship is better left at its present level of adaptation, mostly due to the fact that Joe's Mercury Squares Vic's Sun creating friction.

This aspect illustrates that Joe recognizes Vic's goals and is not in agreement with them.

Liz Libra is the person that keeps things running smoothly. She delicately balances her duties in the group with her high-profile position as a partner in the city's largest law firm.

Liz very much reminds him of his younger sister. (Her Sun in Libra falls in his Third House of siblings).

They have an easy communication. (His Mercury in Gemini Trines her Sun in Libra).

She assists him in his efforts to renovate and beautify the city they both love. (His Moon in Leo Sextiles her Gemini Sun).

She is blonde and attractive; he has fantasized about initiating a relationship with her and intends to ask her out for dinner in a few weeks. (His Neptune in Aquarius Trines her Sun in Gemini.)

Liz seems to be someone with whom he could develop a deeper relationship.

Sam Scorpio has always had his eye on getting the city to purchase the lush, restful area of town near the lake, where Joe's mother's home is located. He envisions turning it into a City Park.

This privately enrages Joe.

Because both his Moon in Leo and Neptune in Aquarius Square Sam's Sun in Scorpio, he has been able to lead Sam to believe he is open to this suggestion.

They however, they have many other differences. (Joe's Sun in Taurus Opposes Sam's Sun in Scorpio.) They are continually putting each other down, and making deprecating jokes about one another.

Joe thinks Sam is way off-base about the plans for a City Park. There is no public transportation or highway near the neighborhood. And, in Joe's mind, this would limit accessibility to the area.

Because Sam's Sun is Inconjunct with Joe's Mercury, Sam sees this as an attractive location for much the same reason. It could be a secluded area for family weekend excursions.

The Inconjunct of Sam's Sun in Scorpio to Joe's Mercury in Gemini displays the incongruence of trying to blend the two signs.

What Joe sees as a drawback to putting a park in that location, Sam sees as positive feature.

They will probably communicate less and less until one of them drops out of the organization.

Sally Sagittarius is in charge of the Travel Committee – she is the Travel Committee.

Twice a year the members travel to cities Sally has researched to see how they are handling Civic Improvements. Sally is quite well educated and she and Joe have had many spirited debates. (Her Sun opposes his Mercury.)

They had a brief affair, in which they had many fun adventures together. (Her Sun falls in Joe's Fifth House of fun and romantic relationships.)

She suddenly broke it off with no explanation (Her Sun Square his Uranus) and they really try to see each other as infrequently as possible now.

He doesn't want to be hurt like that ever again!

Carl Capricorn owns most of the property in the downtown area. He belongs to this group purely to keep an eye on his investments.

In addition, he owns a large Construction firm, and belonging gives him the edge when bids are called for and contracts are passed out.

Joe knows and understands where Carl is coming from regarding keeping an eye on his investments (Joe's Sun in Taurus Trines Carl's Sun in Capricorn).

With Joe's Jupiter conjunct Carl's Sun, Joe has been instrumental in Carl being able to obtain financing for some of his larger project. Their mutual respect for each others' business acumen has deepened their friendship.

Carl is single and they have had a few jovial nights on the town together. This is a lasting friendship based upon mutual respect and genuine understanding. (Carl's Sun Trines Joe's Venus).

Annie Aquarius is usually late for the meeting, or she has written down the wrong time or day. (Her Sun Conjuncts Joe's Neptune).

She is usually available if Joe needs a date and she makes pleasant conversation. (Her Sun Trines Joes' Mercury).

She has explained all of her previous relationships with Joe and he never quite understood what made her break them off. (His Venus Squares her Sun).

She is a Loan Officer for a Mortgage Company and she pretty much keeps her own hours.

Joe has lost a few big mortgage deals to her because she was willing to make evening appointments for her loan clients. (Her Sun Squares His Sun).

He feels very strongly that his customers should think enough of his lending expertise and knowledge to be willing to come to his office during business hours.

But, he is enchanted with Annie's willowy figure and long red hair and spends a good deal of his days going over their dates in his mind. (Her Sun again, conjunct his Neptune).

Her Sun also falls in his Seventh House, so they will probably be able to form a committed relationship.

She is also possibly the girl of his dreams.

Peter Pisces has aligned himself squarely with Sam Scorpio in the plans Sam has for the City Park. (Their Suns Trine each others.)

Peter has amassed quite a bit of debt mostly due to health problems. He drinks heavily, and doesn't always make it into work on time. Because of his spotty work record and declining income, Joe had to reject him from consideration for a bill consolidation loan. (Joe's Saturn in Virgo Opposes Peter's Sun in Pisces in Joe's Eighth House.)

Joe thinks Peter has lied several times in various attempts to obtain other financing. (Joe's Mercury in Gemini Squares Peter's Sun in Pisces.)

Joe views Peter's ability to repay any debts as very shaky. (Peter's Sun Conjunct Joe's Uranus in the Eight House.)

But, he is looking into a financing deal through a broker for Peter. Joe would make a nice profit on the deal without putting his own bank in jeopardy if Peter defaults. (Peter's Sun Conjunct Joe's Uranus in Joe's Eighth House shows some possibilities for an easy unexpected profit).

Chapter Seven: Electional Astrology – Plan the Trip Ahead

Have you ever wanted to know when the best time was to go on a vacation? Look for a new job? Have a party? Or even get married?

The branch of Astrology that gives the gift of timing events is known as Electional Astrology.

Let us say you wanted to have a Mother's Day party for your own mother, your mother-in-law and your sister who is a new mother.

If you cast a chart for Mother's Day, all you have to do is pick the time. The example chart is set for 12:41pm. With a little interpretation, you can judge if this will be a successful venture.

Timing can be important in Electional Astrology, because a few hours one way or another can change all the house cusps.

In an Electional chart, we always use the ascendant to tell us about the event we are planning. Here we see Leo on the Ascendant (First House cusp).

These guests will be treated like royalty. Perhaps you are using Queens as a theme; everyone gets their own crown, sort of a Queen for a Day motif.

(Moon in royal Leo Conjunct the Ascendant).

The Fourth House represents your mother, the Tenth House, your mother-in law (your spouse's mother) and for your sister you look to the Third House.

Since you are the host of the party, we would place you in the First House.

With the Moon hovering so close to the First House cusp from the Twelfth House, this will bring a lot of emotion into the planning of the party.

But, you will want to keep your feelings in check, because the Moon is in the Twelfth House, rather a hidden placement.

Your mother, represented by the Scorpio fourth house, has always been concerned that your mother-in-law seems to spend more time with you and your family.

She is somewhat jealous of the relationship you two have been able to form.

On occasion, your mother has expressed suspicion about your motives for

having this close relationship with your in-laws. You are worried that she may say or do something that will create tension or even an argument. But, we see the circle with the X in the center (called the part of fortune) located in the Fourth House, and the Part of Fortune here says Mom will be nothing but an asset to the occasion.

Pluto is Scorpio's planet, and Pluto is in the Fifth House. This indicates that your mother is coming to have a good time and to see all the children.

Your sister, described by the Third House, wants everyone to see how she has lost all the weight from her recent pregnancy. Libra on the Third House cusp describes her as looking tasteful and attractive.

Venus is Libra's planet and is in the Tenth House (of your mother-in-law).

This tells us that your sister also gets along very well with your mother-in-law and she is looking forward to being in her company.

Venus is also at home with Taurus, this further tells us that your sister is very comfortable with how she looks.

Venus, is not alone in the Tenth House, she sits right next to the Sun. The Sun is Leo's planet and we look to where Leo is to find a clue as to whom she is the fondest.

Leo is on the First House cusp, the house referring to you.

So far, this chart seems like quite an auspicious time for the party. You discuss your plans with your spouse. The Seventh House describing him/her has Aquarius on the cusp. Uranus is the Aquarians planet.

Your spouse indicates, regrettably, (Uranus is in Pisces the sign of regrets) she won't be home from her church meeting until probably two or three in the afternoon.

Looking at the chart drawn up for the party, we see that it will start at a little after noon. We can't make it that much later because that Saturn down into the First House moves closer to the Ascendant as the day wears on.

This could throw a "wet blanket" (Saturn) on the festivities. Therefore, we really need to stick with just a few minutes after noon.

You can learn the most about Electional Astrology by obtaining a chart for an event you know has already taken place. You can use your wedding ceremony, the time you vacationed on a cruise, when you started a new job or anything else where you have a record of when it commenced.

Obtain the time, date and location and have a chart prepared. By using the symbolism of Astrology, as we did above, you are able to describe the event in awesome detail.

With this type of practice, you can familiarize yourself with the areas of the chart and location of the planets that can best enable you to select the timing for success of future ventures.

These charts are used by Astrologers to help point out the best time for important upcoming events, both for themselves and their clients.

Chapter Eight: Horary Astrology – What we did not Plan

The term, "Horary" comes out of the word hour.

We need to know about an area of our life at a certain hour. The questions are endless:

- ? Where is my daughter?
- ? Who took the money?
- ? Will I find work?
- ? Will our marriage last?

Horary Astrology is the tool to use to find these answers.

Symbolically, the answer lies in the phrasing of any question.

As above, so below. This means that at the moment a question is put into words, the answer is borne out in the heavens. Therefore, a chart set up for the exact time a question is asked will contain the answer.

For example, you misplaced your ledger. You look to a chart drawn up for the time when you first ask yourself the question "Where is my ledger?" We will again use this chart.

We see that Leo is on the First House cusp. In Horary charts, the First House describes the querent (that is one asking the question). You, as the querent in this case would be described as bright and sunny and just out for some fun.

You had a rather hectic social schedule all weekend so you left work early and were in a hurry to run a few errands before going home to get ready for the two parties on Friday evening.

On Saturday, you took the children to the Amusement Park and that evening you and your spouse went out for dinner and dancing.

Now, it's Sunday and you need to find that ledger to take with you to work on Monday morning!

This ledger contains very important figures you have been using to prepare the quarterly budget for the Gold and Silver Commodities your investment firm purchases.

Since these figures fluctuate, it would take many hours of research to reconstruct them. This means you better find the ledger.

We will have to decide where that ledger would be best symbolized in the chart drawn up for the time you first asked yourself the question. Written documents, papers and ledgers are symbolized by Mercury and Mercury's home base the Third House. The sign on the third house cusp is Libra. Libra likes to balance things, so the ledger is up to date and more valuable because of Libra's liking for important items.

We see that that planet always symbolized by Libra, (Venus) is in the Tenth House of Career. This indicates the ledger is critically important to your profession.

Venus is conjunct the Sun. We learned that the sun's brilliant rays can sometimes block out the light of other planets that are near. We also know that the Sun favors Leo, Leo is the sign on the ascendant that signifies you! You retrace your steps, from the time you walked in the house on Friday. As you pass the library table in the upstairs hallway you glance at the gold framed picture of you on vacation last summer dressed up to look like Elvis Presley, "The King".

As you look away you realize there was something next to the picture. Could it be? You walk back to the table and tucked away on the side of the brilliant yellow picture frame is your ledger.

Symbolically, Venus, representing the lost item, posited up high in the chart (Tenth House) says the item will be on an upper floor. Venus conjunct the Sun made it more difficult to see the ledger (Venus) because of the shiny picture frame (Sun) catching your attention.

Another tool which is often used in Horary work is the Moon. Here, the Moon is placed in the cadent Twelfth (cadent) House in (Fixed sign) Leo. When the

Moon is in a fixed sign and a Cadent house in Horary Astrology, it can be said that no action will take place without some assistance. When you mentioned the fiasco with the ledger to your wife that evening, she laughed, and said, "You should have asked me where the ledger was. I put it up there Friday so it wouldn't get misplaced."

If this branch of Astrology is one you would like to know more about, there are some excellent books on the subject in the Travelogue chapter.

Chapter Nine: Mundane Astrology – What We Cannot Plan




Figure 2: Above is a chart for the United States of America. There are many different charts in use. This is one of the more commonly used. We will explore, using the houses, some of the issues at stake in the founding of America.

<u>First House-Ascendant:</u> We see Sagittarius here. The first house in a county's chart describes its inhabitants. Sagittarius says the people were from foreign countries, but with a common philosophy.

Jupiter resonates to the sign Sagittarius. Jupiter is in the Seventh House (of partners), indicating that the forming of this country was a partnership of like minds.

Jupiter also gives hope and optimism to America's people.

Second House: Capricorn is on the cusp of this house. The second house deals with the resources and values of a nation. Capricorn describes these as stern values and limited resources. The country was not awash in cash.

However, they firmly held to their principles. We see that Saturn, the planet correlating with Capricorn, is in the Tenth House (of bosses). We can infer that the first president was a thrifty, moralistic leader. Americans will seek out any future leaders with these qualities as well.

Third House: Aquarius is on the cusp here. In Mundane work, the third house has to do with the media, orators and written documents.

We know of Aquarius' love of change and reform. We are also aware of the contrariness and independence that can be associated with this sign. From the beginning, this country has always had a decidedly autonomous press. Moreover, The Declaration of Independence is its founding document. At the time, orators were in great demand; they served up fiery rhetoric, and argued that the people be delivered from their subjugation to England.

The Moon in the Third House loves changes (remember how the Moon goes through its monthly cycle of phases?) The speeches and writings at the time the US declared its independence reflect that need for change, "in order to form a more perfect union".

Aquarius enjoys working towards perfection.

Fourth House: On the Fourth House cusp, we see Aries. The Fourth House is the beginning and ending of a country.

Aries and its planet Mars are warring indicators. With Aries on this house cusp and its Planet Mars conjunct the Seventh House cusp of open enemies, the placements refers to the Revolutionary War that started this country's press for freedom.

None of us knows how this country will end, however Mars and its corresponding sign Aries allows us some concepts for conjecture.

Fifth House: In this chart, the Fifth house holds the same sign as the Fourth. This means that the interests of these two houses are common. Here, we see Aries again only this time moving into the area of recreation and enjoyment (Fifth House).

Did our founding fathers enjoy the battles they fought to win their independence? If this charts symbolic meaning has any credence, we have to think that they very much enjoyed engaging the open enemy in war!

Are there any forms of enjoyment in our culture today that reflect this same symbolism? They abound! Football, Boxing, NASCAR, X-box, Play Station and Wii games of combat are some outstanding examples of warring for amusement.

Sixth House: This is the house of work and health issues. Taurus (the bull) on the cusp tells us that this must be a hard working group of people.

Health care, once considered a luxury (Taurus's association with Venus), has become a commodity you customarily pay for at work. Today, the theme of people keeping their much despised jobs in order to have there health care provided, is a recurring one.

Nevertheless, all this hard work and subordination of the desire for a job you can like, makes us feel entitled to the best, most costly health care in the world.

Seventh House: Gemini on the cusp signifies the importance of communication. Whether it is with our significant others or with our open enemies, we feel the need to keep in contact. This can be through a scribbled post-it note on the refrigerator or a hastily prepared communiqué handed to a trusted emissary; we feel the deep pressing need for communication.

Venus, the Sun and Jupiter located here and all in the sign Cancer reflect the importance we place on the individual citizens of all the nations across the globe. Venus says we care, Jupiter describes our massive generosity and the Sun elevates in magnitude our nurturing (Cancer) small countries.

With the Sun in the Seventh house of any chart, be it the personal horoscope, a horary chart or in this mundane example, there will be a major emphasis on the relationships we maintain with all foreign governments. The Sun here also places enormous importance on any enemies we engender.

Eighth House: Here we have the sign Cancer on the cusp of the house signaling other people's money. Cancer and her corresponding Moon, are the everyday folks: John Q. Public.

This is the core of the prevalent assumption that the public treasury is the people's money. In other countries, once a person is taxed, they no longer view that money as theirs.

In the U.S., we still see it as our money even after it has been taken away from us through assessments.

Another thing we see with the sign Cancer's relationship to the Moon, is that economic policies in this country go through many phases. High tariffs, low tariffs, high interest rates, low interest rates; like the Moon guiding the tides, we see tidal like fluctuations in the policies that shape the economy.

Ninth House: Much like in the natal birth chart, the Ninth House in Mundane work exemplifies distant lands and foreign relations.

With Leo on this house cusp, foreign lands were mostly Monarchies when our nation was formed. Some of our most steadfast allies are still Kings, Queens and Princes.

Leo also refers to the blinding optimism that has spurred many of our international ventures. The ninth house also holds sway over higher learning, colleges, universities and their areas of study. College degrees are "king" (Leo) when our natives step into the work force.

Tenth House: With the sign Libra on the house of our leaders of government, we are very much a nation of laws. In fact, most of the leaders have law degrees.

We see Saturn here also in Libra. The law is the law. Every aspect of our daily lives reflects the reliance we have on the Constitution and its laws.

Saturn is very comfortable here, bringing out in rigorous detail the prohibitions and privileges that are inherent in our founding document.

Libra always wants to be in balance, so the framers decided on a bicameral legislature. Checks and balances are a hallmark of the United States Government at work.

Eleventh House: All the hopes and aspirations of the people are signified in this House. We note that Libra is on this house cusp also as it was on the Tenth. Our governing bodies and we have similar aspirations shown by the repeating of Libra on Ten and Eleven. The hope here is to maintain the balance we have structured into our governing process. Our aspirations are for a balanced and centered form of administering our beloved Constitution.

Organizations are also a part of the Eleventh House. With Libra on the cusp, even this country's non-governmental agencies attempt to diplomatically (Libra) weigh and balance all opinions before issuing their positions.

Twelfth House: We have Scorpio on the cusp of the house of our undoing. Scorpio does things secretly. Scorpio likes to watch unnoticed. Scorpio has much jealousy and thrives on retribution.

Since there are no planets occupying this house it is of lesser notice, however, the stern warning here is that secret, behind the scenes spying and ruthless acts can be the downfall of this great nation.

Scorpio resonates to the planet Pluto, situated in the Second House of our values as well as what we own in a material sense. This indicates just how much these vengeful, surreptitious actions can destroy our values and resources.

Administering to the poor, the ill and the criminals are also represented in this House.

Scorpio and the planet Pluto signify that these members of society get what they pay for and pay for what they get. Adequately funding (Pluto in the Second) for the above causes and institutions could also strip the public coffers bare.
